**Senate Democratic Leader Dianne Hesselbein Statement
on Legislative Fiscal Bureau Revenue Estimate**

Senator Dianne Hesselbein (D-Middleton), the Senate Democratic Leader, released the following statement in response to the Legislative Fiscal Bureau release of Revenue Estimates:

"It is good news for Wisconsin that the non-partisan Legislative Fiscal Bureau now estimates revenues at the end of the 2025-2027 biennium will exceed projections by over \$1.5 billion.

This good news is a tribute to Wisconsin Democrats, who have prioritized investments in the people of Wisconsin that have improved our state's economy, provided middle class tax relief, and helped make Wisconsin a state where businesses want to invest and families want to live.

The bi-partisan 2025-2027 budget, which I helped negotiate, advances those important priorities.
